Read or listen to **Fire Engine Man** by Andrea Zimmerman to learn about what firefighters do to keep us safe. Talk about how firefighters help our communities, what are the most important parts of the job? Would your child like to be a firefighter? Why or why not?

Discover

Talk about fire safety in your home. Work together to make a plan about what to do in case of a fire. Talk about safe ways to exit the house in case of a fire and agree on a safe place for your family to meet outside.

Explore

Check out the **Western Reserve Fire Museum and Education Center** downtown. Kids can learn about fire safety from experts. There's also a small play area and some kid-sized gear so that kids can dress up like an actual firefighter!

Admission is \$8 for adults, \$5 for kids older than 3, and **FREE** for kids under 3.
